

GENERAL INFORMATION

Students are required to purchase the following materials for their personal use in class. Some items can be used across a variety of classes and can be re-used from one year to the next. PLEASE NOTE: Nikko pens, paper clips, metal rulers and liquid paper are NOT PERMITTED at school. Separate exercise books are required for individual subjects. 5-Subject Books are NOT permitted. **Scientific calculators (\$27.65) and are available from the school office.**

GENERAL STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

The following general stationery items are required in all classes. Parents should regularly check that their child has these items and replace them as required.

- **School bag, lunch box and pencil case.**

RESPONSIBILITIES

Learning is enhanced when students arrive well prepared for class. Students, parents, teachers and the school have shared responsibility for this as outlined below.



Parents
Parents are responsible for providing the required materials for learning each year and replace/replenish these items as required throughout the year. They should frequently check school bags for cleanliness, required equipment and personal organisation and teach their children to be organised for learning. Parents should seek support from the school where they are experiencing financial difficulties and unable to provide the required equipment to support their child's learning.

Students
Students are required to bring all materials to class each lesson, keep learning materials well organised and advise their parents of items require replenishment.

Teachers
Teachers are responsible for monitoring that students have the required materials and are bringing these to class every day. They will teach their students to be well organised for their class and should advise parents when required materials are not being brought to class.

School
The school will support families experiencing financial difficulties who are unable to provide the required equipment to support their child's learning.
