Key Terminology

There are a few key terms that students need to have a clear understanding of in order to choose their Senior Schooling pathway. These terms are outlined below.

Senior Education and Training (SET) Planning

Your SET plan helps you:

- structure your learning around your abilities, interests and ambitions
- think about your education, training and career options after Year 12
- set and achieve your learning goals in Years 11 and 12, and beyond
- include flexible and coordinated pathway options in your course of senior study
- communicate with your parents/carers or teachers/careers counsellors about your post-school plans.
- put plans in place to be successful in <u>Senior School and BEYOND</u>

Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)

Queensland's senior school qualification is:

- internationally recognised
- achievement based
- flexible letting you choose what, where and when you study.

To attain a QCE students need to satisfy the following requirements:

- Literacy requirement pass at least one unit* of an English subject.
- Numeracy requirement pass at least one unit* of a Maths subject.
- 12 points of completed core earned by completing entire subjects at a pass. (Need to start and finish 3 subjects passing all 4 units).
 - Can also be done by completing Certificate II or III courses and accumulating points from them where a Certificate II is generally worth four points and a Certificate III is generally worth eight points.

Plus, a further eight points to make a total of

Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA)

The Queensland Certificate of Individual Achievement (QCIA) recognises the achievements of students who are on individualised learning programs.

The certificate is an official record that students have completed at least 12 years of education, and provides students with a summary of their skills and knowledge that they can present to employers and training providers.

ATAR – Australian Tertiary Admission Rank


Queensland ATARs are based on a student's:

- best five General subject results, OR
- best results in four General subjects, plus one Applied subject, OR
- best results in four General subjects, plus one VET qualification at Certificate III or above.

Important to note

To be eligible for an ATAR, students must successfully complete an English subject (General or Applied).

Vocational Education

Vocational Education and Training (VET) refers to education and training that focuses on delivering skills and knowledge required for specific industries. It is a learning option for young people in the senior phase of learning.

Laidley School is a registered RTO through the QCAA and may deliver VET to students in Years 11 and 12.

CPC10120 Certificate I in Construction /CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction Pathways
