# But first, let's set some goals for Year 10

- Setting goals is an effective way to increase motivation and to help you to create the changes you want.
- SMART goals are used to set meaningful and achievable goals



**S**

• **SPECIFIC**

- Define the goal as much as possible with no unclear language
- **Who** is involved, **WHAT** do I want to accomplish, **WHERE** will it be done, **WHY** am I doing this – reasons, purpose, **WHICH** constraints and/or requirements do I have?

**M**

• **MEASURABLE**

- Can you track the progress and measure the outcome?
- How much, how many, how will I know when my goal is accomplished?

**A**

• **ATTAINABLE/ACHIEVABLE**

- Is the goal reasonable enough to be accomplished? How so?
- Make sure the goal is not out or reach or below standard performance.

**R**

• **RELEVANT**

- Is the goal worthwhile and will it meet your needs?
- Is each goal consistent with the other goals you have established and fits with your immediate and long term plans?

**T**

• **TIMELY**

- Your objective should include a time limit. Ex: I will complete this step by month/day/year.
- It will establish a sense of urgency and prompt you to have better time management.

# Setting Your Goals

- These goal are ones that you believe will enable you to:
  - Improve my learning outcomes and make my best better
  - Enjoy school more
  - Get what I want from my education
- **For example**
  - **Specific:** I would like to begin a school based traineeship in the hospitality industry by the start of semester 2 in year 10
  - **Measurable:** I can measure this goal by completing the processes towards gaining this SBT and submitting my paperwork
  - **Attainable:** I can work with Mrs King to achieve this. I am consistently attending school and I behave while I am at school.
  - **Relevant:** I would like to be a chef when I finish school so this is a good pathway to achieve my future career
  - **Timely:** I would like to be accepted into the SBT by Semester 2 of year 10

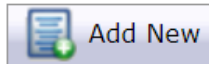

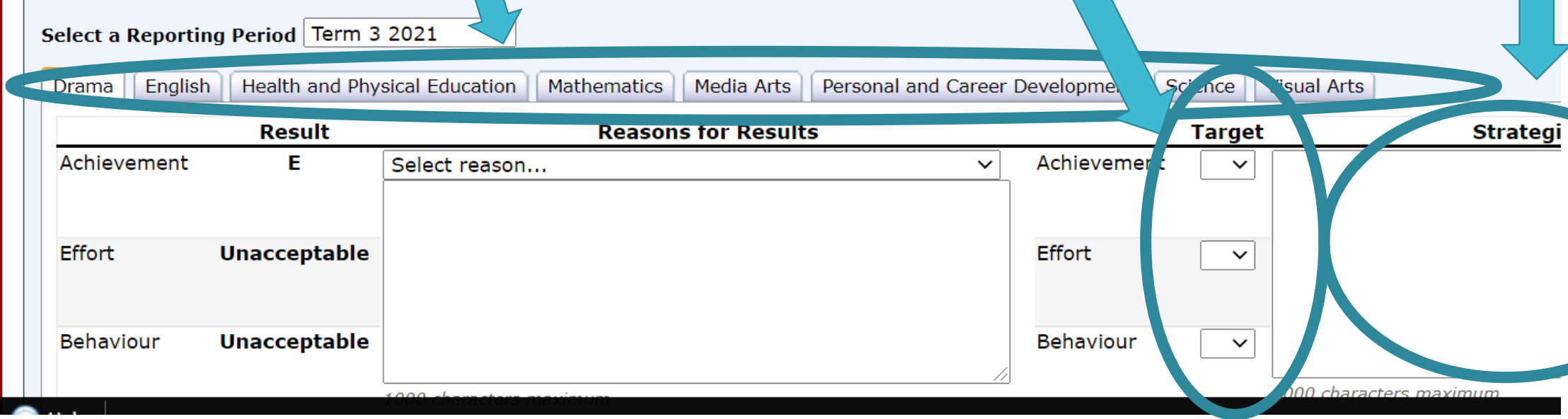
